## CAMBRIDGESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (NEWTOWN AREA, CAMBRIDGE) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND ONE-WAY STREETS) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2021

The Cambridgeshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Parking) Act 1986 and of all other enabling powers after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 20th day of January 2021 for a period not exceeding 18 months and may be cited as the "Cambridgeshire County Council (Newtown Area, Cambridge) (Prohibition of Driving and One-way Streets) Experimental Order 2021".
- In this Order:

"Council" means the Cambridgeshire County Council;

"Motor vehicle" has the same meaning as stated in Sections 136(1) and 140 of the 1984 Act.

- 3. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to any motor vehicle being used by or on behalf of
  - (i) an individual, party or organisation authorised by the Council;
  - (ii) the police, fire brigade or ambulance service.
- 5. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in any of the roads or lengths of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road or length of road in Column 2 of that Schedule.
- 6. The City of Cambridge Area A Consolidation Order 1993 is hereby varied and shall have effect as though in Schedule 6 One-Way Streets the following words were deleted:

"Norwich Street

From east to west

Panton Street (from its junction with Russell Court to its junction with Lensfield Road)

From south to north"
